ANZSNR RESEARCH GRANT - OPEN FOR APPLICATIONS

The ANZSNR Research Grant aims to provide 'booster' funding for research projects in neurodiagnostic radiology, Head and Neck Radiology and Interventional Neuroradiology. Three grants of \$5,000AUD will be awarded to recipients who demonstrate they have met the selection criteria (as listed in the application form).

Applications are open to ANZSNR members who are <5 years post Fellowship. After submitting your application, an email will be sent to you confirming that your application has been received. The review process will take 4-6 weeks. Successful applicants will be notified in writing.
