
The application and accompanying criteria have been approved by the Council and will be open to eligible members from August 2023.

RANZCR INR SPECIALTY RECOGNITION AND TRAINING PATHWAY UPDATE

Specialty Recognition

Advocating for the specialty of INR is a long and complex process that involves submitting a series of applications to the Medical Board of Australia (MBA) and the Medical Council of New Zealand. In early 2023, RANZCR submitted the first of two applications to the MBA to recognise INR as a NEW field of specialty practice of radiology. This year, the college is working towards an application for New Zealand.

IR Training Program

To complement this work, the IRC together with the IR and INR Training Pathway working group is designing a training pathway that will be built upon the basic interventional skills gained in core clinical radiology training program to offer a seamless, dedicated Fellowship level program for all clinical radiologists who choose to specialise in interventional radiology or interventional neuroradiology in Australia and New Zealand.
